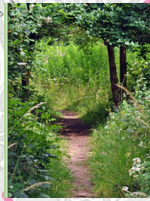

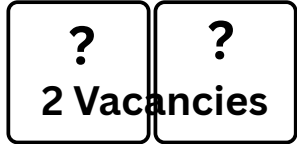

Walderslade and Lordswood - Boxley Parish Council is fully responsible for 100 acres of Walderslade Woodlands which is a major local asset. We are producing new management plans. Please join our volunteers.

Lidsing - Allocated in the MBC 2024 Local Plan as a garden village of 2,000 houses and new employment. We are working hard to ensure that the impact of this development on the infrastructure, particularly the road network and services, of our existing communities is minimised as much as possible.

Sandling - Working on the A229 changes and with the KCC Active Travel Team to improve the shared path on Old Chatham Road.

Boxley - We have been surveying traffic flows through the village to find ways to protect the village and its residents. We are in the process of major repairs to the assets of the closed churchyard.

Grove Green and Weavering - Maidstone Borough Council is conducting a Community Governance Review of this area and is asking residents if they wish to keep the existing Parish Council governance arrangements in Grove Green or would they prefer something different. There is a detailed leaflet on our website and Facebook. All residents are able to complete the consultation as it affects the whole parish.
