TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Boarley Lane, Sandling will be closed to through traffic, on 27th April 2026 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed just passed the Grange Lane Turning before Tyland Lane.

The alternative route is via Boarley Lane, Grange Lane, Old Chatham Road, Sandling Lane, Running Horse Roundabout, Royal Engineers Road, Chatham Road, Cobtree Roundabout, M20 Junction 6 from junction 5 Off Slip, Blue Bell Hill, Kits Coty Slip Northbound Off, Rochester Road, Kits Coty Slip Southbound On, Tyland Lane, and vice versa.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patch repair to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
